An Invitation to Join

Sunset Hill Community Association (SHCA) is one of Seattle's oldest neighborhood associations. We formed in 1922, and in 1929 members purchased land and built our two-story clubhouse, providing a hall for community activities.

Membership is open to all, no matter where you live. The yearly fee is \$15 per adult. Those who reside between NW Market Street and NW 85th Street and from Puget Sound to 24th Avenue NW have voting privileges.

As a member, you get invitations to special events and discounts on some events, such as wine/beer tastings. Activities that take place in our building include yoga, fitness, and children's music classes; kids' movie nights; craft and solstice fairs; dances; orchestra performances; Ballard Civic Orchestra rehearsals; Ballard Historical Society, Ballard Writers' Collective, Sustainable Ballard, Ballard District Council, and Weight Watchers meetings and events; and much more.

A volunteer board of trustees is elected annually from the voting members. Board members oversee the upkeep of the building and help keep members apprised of issues that affect our neighborhood and the city, including bus routes, local development, homelessness, and more. SHCA represents our neighborhood, holding a seat on the Ballard District Council.

Board meetings are typically held from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. on the fourth Monday of each month, in the clubhouse office.

We hope you'll take this opportunity to join SHCA, meet fellow residents, and enhance the neighborhood you call home.
