Sunset Hill Community Association (SHCA) is one of Seattle’s oldest neighborhood associations. It was formed in 1922 and in 1929 members purchased land and built the two-story Clubhouse to provide the residents and children of Sunset Hill with a hall for community activities.

Membership is open to all. Those who reside between NW Market Street and NW 85th Street and from Puget Sound to 24th Avenue NW have voting privileges.

A volunteer board of trustees is elected annually from the voting members. Officers communicate with public officials on issues that affect our neighborhood and the city, including public transport, local development, and quality-of-life issues. SHCA represents our neighborhood, holding a seat on the Ballard District Council.

Board meetings are typically held at 7:15 on the fourth Wednesday of each month in the Clubhouse office.

SHCA has various committees that serve the organization, such as Finance, Building, Land Use, Programs, Membership, Communications and Business.

Board members and committees oversee the organization’s finances; maintain the building, and manage it as a rental facility. The Land Use committee seeks to research and inform residents about development issues. The Program committee organizes meetings and events that include local political Candidate Forum, Ballot Issue discussions, Ballard Filmmakers, Ballard Writers' Workshop, Motown Dance Parties, our annual Wine Tasting, and the highly successful Kids Movie Night series. Finally, the Membership committee communicates with members through mailings, email and via our website at www.sunsethillcommunity.org.
